


## **Child Care Teachers**

In May & June 2022, the <u>Study of Early Education through Partnerships</u> conducted a survey of early educators in Virginia working with children ages 0-5. Over half of teachers working at surveyed child care centers (54%) completed the 2022 survey, including 1,892 lead teachers and 551 assistant teachers. This profile describes those teachers.

### **DEMOGRAPHICS**

### **RACE/ETHNICITY**

About half of teachers at child care centers are people of color.



#### HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION

55%

of lead teachers and 49% of assistant teachers are married or living with partner.

54%

of lead teachers and 45% of assistant teachers have children under the age of 18.


#### **TEACHER GENDER**

Nearly all lead (98%) & assistant (97%) teachers at child care centers are female.


of lead teachers and 24% of assistant teachers speak a language besides English.

of lead teachers and 14% of assistant teachers hold a CDA credential.



## **EDUCATOR WELLBEING**

#### **HOUSEHOLD INCOME**

Most child care teachers have total household incomes (pre-tax) below \$45,000 per year.



#### **PAY PER HOUR**

On average, lead teachers earn \$14.41 per hour and assistant teachers earn \$13.48 per hour.

#### **FOOD INSECURITY**

of lead teachers and 53% of assistant teachers are experiencing food insecurity.



of lead teachers and 34% of assistant teachers are exhibiting clinically relevant symptoms of depression.


#### **HEALTH INSURANCE**

#### SOCIAL SUPPORTS AND BENEFITS RECEIVED


45% of lead teachers and 41% of assistant teachers received some kind of social support or benefit in the past month, including...

## **TEACHER RETENTION**

About two-thirds of teachers said it was very likely they would still be at their site in 3 months, and just over a third said they expected to still be there in 3 years.
